## *We support local ministries*



We've been talking about **Family Promise** a lot in these past few weeks as we look forward to hosting families November 3-10. But don't forget that we support several other local ministries as well.

In the fellowship hall is a receptacle for **Hagar's Basket**, which provides hygiene products and other items needed by local middle and high schoolers. Mike Holley oversees our efforts and coordinates our efforts with St. Bart's Church.

There is also a receptacle for CMONA (Community Ministry of North Augusta), which provides compassionate, holistic, and Christ-centered assistance to low-income individuals and families. Monte Steedley periodically carries goods to CMONA from Holy Trinity.

Cumbee Center to Assist Abused Persons was established to aid victims of domestic violence. Twyla occasionally contacts a representative of CAAP to deliver goods to the shelter.

Printed on the fronts of all four receptacles are some of the needs of these ministries. Let us continue to strive to be the hands and feet and heart of Jesus in our local community.

*Thanks to Myrle Wilson and Dea Baldwin, for the idea of welcoming our Rector in this practical way. Your generosity is only surpassed by your love!*

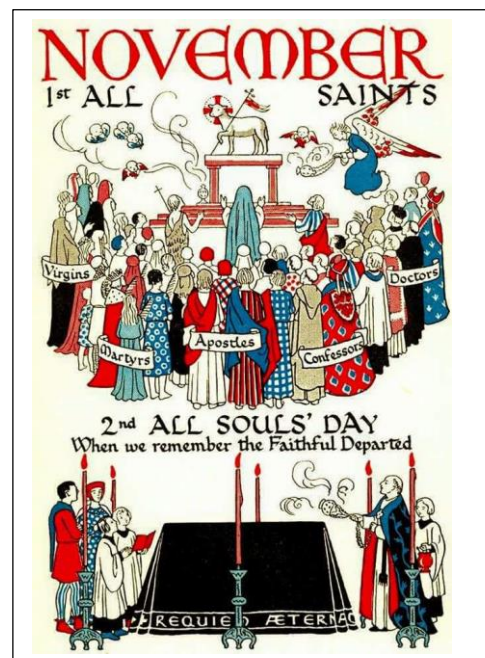
*The Women's Bible Study*
