Ordinary Season

On Quietness Before Worship

The Anglican way of worship each Sunday is all about prayer. When we gather together as God's people on Sunday, we gather to offer our prayers of praise, confession, intercession, and thanksgiving. God's desire is for his people, wherever we are gathered, to be a house of prayer. "And the foreigners who join themselves to the Lord, to minister to him, to love the name of the Lord, and to be his servants, everyone who keeps the Sabbath and does not profane it, and holds fast my covenant—these I will bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer; their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples" (Is. 56:6-7).

As we gather together in our nave for worship each week, remember to gather in prayer. Enter into the nave in quietness as others will be preparing their hearts for worship. Take a moment to kneel at your seat, to offer a prayer to prepare your own heart, and then sit in quietness as you quiet your heart from the busyness of your morning. We are a very welcoming people here at Holy Trinity and often, our welcoming nature gets rather loud prior to our worship together. As we welcome others, do so in quietness as many have already begun their prayers. One of the opening prayers of daily Morning Prayer is, "The Lord is in his holy temple; let all the earth keep silence before him" (Hab. 2:20). May the Lord inhabit the prayers of his people each week as we worship together at Holy Trinity.
